THE RULES - All of the theme days will operate under the same dress code standards. Students may not wear items of clothing that are too short, low cut, revealing, in disrepair or suggestive in any way. Students are also not allowed to wear sleeveless or spaghetti strap tops. Students should not wear any articles of clothing that encourage or advertise alcohol, tobacco or inappropriate behaviors. Shorts with leggings are NOT permitted, nor are any bathing suits or leotards of any kind. Students should make a concerted effort to dress in an OBVIOUS theme, rather than just dressing in plain clothes and throwing on one small article that works with the theme. Students who violate these basic rules will be required to change into uniform which may require parents to bring uniform clothing to the school, so parents please be vigilant when approving your children's choice of costume. If in doubt about the appropriateness of an outfit, bring a change of clothes.
