### **Attendance and Grading:**

Attendance will be counted through punctual submission of learning modules. Learning modules will be posted by 8:00 am. Students should check Canvas courses for assigned work. All grades for assignments will be posted on MyBackpack.

# **Academic Integrity:**

Online learning requires students to practice personal academic integrity. Students will be expected to abide by Trinity's academic covenant on all assignments.

# **Digital Office Hours:**

Teachers will have digital office hours from 9:00 am - Noon daily. This is the time for students to ask any questions they may have about their assignments. Teachers will have their email open and will respond quickly to students' questions. Students seeking help should email from their Trinity email address. Students are welcome to communicate with teachers outside of this time but may not receive an immediate response. We will operate on the MWF school schedule; if teachers need to hold a live session, it will be scheduled during their MWF class time.
