I hope this message finds you and your family well during this unprecedented and challenging time.

The dedication and love for your students by the talented faculty and staff at Trinity has perhaps never been more evident than over these last few weeks. A full and robust education experience is continuing here at Trinity albeit in a different form than we have previously experienced. Social distancing does not mean Trinity is disconnected.
